REVIEW: HIS ENTRY IS OUR EXIT!

Lk 19:35 They brought it to Jesus, and they threw their coats on the colt and put Jesus on it. 36 As He was going, they were spreading their coats on the road. 37 As soon as He was approaching, near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles which they had seen, 38 shouting: "BLESSED IS THE KING WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

1. NEVER SHUT HIM OUT

WHERE HE CANNOT ENTER, THE BONDAGE CANNOT EXIT

Mk 16:4 Looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away, although it was extremely large. 5 Entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting at the right, wearing a white robe; and they were amazed. 6 And he said to them, "Do not be amazed; you are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who has been crucified. He has risen; He is not here; behold, here is the place where they laid Him. 7 "But go, tell His disciples and Peter, `He is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see Him, just as He told you.'" 8 They went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had gripped them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid

1. THEY FLED THE SCENE AND DESERTED HIM

MARK 14.50 THEY ALL FLED// MARK 16.11 THEY DID NOT BELIEVE

HE FORGAVE THEM AND ACTED AS IF IT NEVER HAPPENED

HE FORGAVE PETER AS IF HE WAS A WINNER!

Mt 26:69 Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard, and a servant-girl came to him and said, "You too were with Jesus the Galilean." 70 But he denied it before them all, saying, "I do not know what you are talking about." 71 When he had gone out to the gateway, another servant-girl saw him and said to those who were there, "This man was with Jesus of Nazareth." 72 And again he denied it with an oath, "I do not know the man." 73 A little later the bystanders came up and said to Peter, "Surely you too are one of them; for even the way you talk gives you away." 74 Then he began to curse and swear, "I do not know the man!" And immediately a rooster crowed. 75 And Peter remembered the word which Jesus had said, "Before a rooster crows, you will deny Me three times." And he went out and wept bitterly.

2. THE CROSS FIXED OUR PAST

HIS DEATH FOREVER SETTLED THE MISTAKES WE MADE

Heb 9:11 But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things to come, He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; 12 and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. 13 For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, 14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

HIS DEATH SET UP THE NEW COVENANT

Heb 9:16 For where a covenant is, there must of necessity be the death of the one who made it. 17 For a covenant is valid only when men are dead, for it is never in force while the one who made it lives. 18 Therefore even the first covenant was not inaugurated without blood.

NOTES: THE NEW AGREEMENT NOT ONLY BROUGHT FORGIVENESS BUT THE SPIRIT COMES TO WRITE THE LAWS OF GOD ON OUR HEARTS. THE NEW AGREEMENT INCLUDED FORGIVENESS, HEALING, PROVISION, COMPLETE LIFE CHANGE.

THE BLOOD FIXED PETERS PAST DENIAL BUT IF HE DID IT ONCE HE COULD DO IT AGAIN!

3. RESURRECTION FIXED OUR FUTURE

HE GOT UP TO ENFORCE THE FREEDOM

1 John 2:1 My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous. (NLT)

HE LIVES TO STAND IN OUR PLACE

Hebrews 7:25 Therefore he is able, once and forever, to save those who come to God through him. He lives forever to intercede with God on their behalf. (NLT)

HIS RESURRECTED LIFE CHANGES OUR FUTURE

THERE IS A REASON WHY HE WANTED PETER AND THE OTHER DISCIPLES. I PROMISE YOU THAT IF JUDAS HAD NOT COMMITTED SUICIDE HE WOULD HAVE FORGIVEN HIM TOO!

Romans 8:28,29 And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.

For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.
