- Stand up for what’s right and can protest against injustice without hurting someone else.




## MEMORY VERSE

So when she heard grown-ups talk about wiping out Birmingham’s segregation laws, she spoke up. As she listened to the preacher’s words, smooth as glass, she sat up tall. And when she heard the plan—picket those white stores! March to protest those unfair laws! Fill the jails! —she stepped right up and said, I’ll do it! She was going to j-a-a-ill!

Audrey Faye Hendricks was confident and bold and brave as can be, and hers is the remarkable and inspiring story of one child’s role in the Civil Rights Movement.
