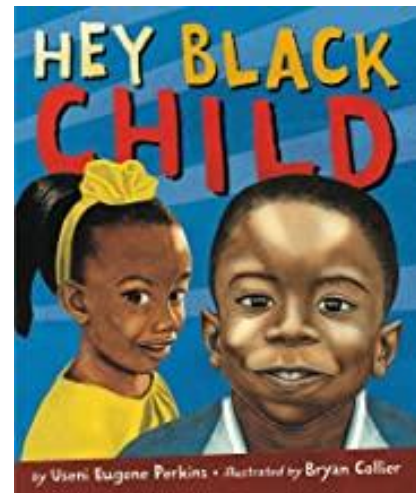

Suddenly there was a noise from the sky which sounded like a strong wind blowing, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then they saw what looked like tongues of fire which spread out and touched each person there. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to talk in other languages, as the Spirit enabled them to speak. Those who believed were baptized and added to the church that day—about 3,000 in all.

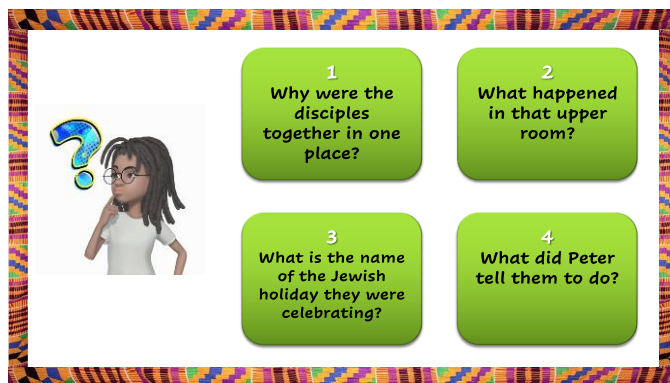

BLACK HISTORY MOMENT...



Maya Angelou, born Marguerite Anne Johnson, was an American, actress, screenwriter, dancer, poet, and civil rights activist. She was the first black San Francisco cable car conductor. She earned 50 honorary degrees and wrote 36 books. She is best known for her book, *I Know Why the Caged Birds Sing*, was the first non-fiction, best seller by an African American woman. She recited poem at President Bill Clinton's 1993 inauguration and was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President Barak Obama in 2011.

**Refused to give up her seat
9 months before Rosa Parks**

Nine months before Rosa Parks, there was Claudette Colvin, a 15-year-old who refused to give up her seat to a White person on a bus in Montgomery, Alabama. She was pulled off the bus and arrested. Later, she and other African Americans challenged the law in court. The Supreme Court ordered the city of Montgomery and the state of Alabama, to end bus segregation.
