**Acts of the Apostles 2:1** On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place.:2 Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting.:3 Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them.:4 And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.:5 At that time there were devout Jews from every nation living in Jerusalem.:6 When they heard the loud noise, everyone came running, and they were bewildered to hear their own languages being spoken by the believers.:7 They were completely amazed. “How can this be?” they exclaimed. “These people are all from Galilee,:8 and yet we hear them speaking in our own native languages! :9 Here we are — Parthians, Medes, Elamites, people from Mesopotamia, Judea, Cappadocia, Pontus, the province of Asia, :10 Phrygia, Pamphylia, Egypt, and the areas of Libya around Cyrene, vis from Rome :11 (both Jews and converts to Judaism), Cretans, and Arabs. And we all hear these people speaking in our own languages about the wonderful things God has done!”:12 They stood there amazed and perplexed. “What can this mean?” they asked each other.

**2:40** Then Peter continued preaching for a long time, strongly urging all his listeners, “Save yourselves from this crooked generation!” :41 Those who believed what Peter said were baptized and added to the church that day— about 3,000 in all.
