HOSANNA BRANCH WEVERS

- Green construction paper- 4 sheets
- 4-8 jumbo craft sticks
- Clear tape
- A pencil
- Scissors
- A glue-stick



Instructions:

- Outline your child's hand on the green construction paper.
- Cut out the around the handprints.
- Glue hand branches to the craft sticks
- Wave!

FLIP A RAINBOW



Materials:

- White Paper
- Markers
- Tall glass or vase
- Water

Color a row of rainbow colors from left to right on your paper. Attach your paper to a wall or hold it up. Fill your vase with water and you are ready to go. Move glass slowly in front of the rainbow and watch the colors appear to flip

This is a basic demonstration of light refraction (bending of the light) and reflection
