Scripture: MATTHEW 20:28

SZN 3: LEAD LIKE JESUS

“Then the mother of Zebedee’s sons came to Jesus with her sons and, kneeling down, asked a favor of him. “What is it you want?” he asked. She said, “Grant that one of these two sons of mine may sit at your right and the other at your left in your kingdom.” “You don’t know what you are asking,” Jesus said to them. “Can you drink the cup I am going to drink?” “We can,” they answered. Jesus said to them, “You will indeed drink from my cup, but to sit at my right or left is not for me to grant. These places belong to those for whom they have been prepared by my Father.” When the ten heard about this, they were indignant with the two brothers. Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers of the Gentiles Lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave— just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.””

### H. HUMBLE APPROACH

Salaome- The Mother of James and John

Salome- Shalom-Peace

—In [Mark 15:40–41](#), the women present at the [crucifixion](#) who also ministered to Jesus: "There were also women looking on afar off: among whom was [Mary Magdalene](#), and Mary the mother of [James](#) and of [Joses](#); and Salome who also followed Him and ministered to Him when he was in Galilee. And many other women who followed Him to Jerusalem." ([15:40–41](#), [King James Version](#))

-[Matthew 27:56](#) reads thus: "Among which was Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James and Joses, and the mother of Zebedee's children."

-Mark, Salome is among the women who went to Jesus' tomb to anoint his body with spices. "And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him." (Mark [16:1](#) KJV) They discovered that the [stone had been rolled away](#), and a young man in white then told them that Jesus had risen, and told them to tell Jesus' disciples that he would meet them in [Galilee](#).

-Matthew 28:1, two women are mentioned in the parallel passage: Mary Magdalene and the "other Mary" – identified previously in Matthew 27:56 as Mary the mother of James and Josés.

1. Salome still approaches lowly and humble
2. Salome still, is identified with the Husband, Where is Zebedee and why didn't he ask?
3. This woman's name is unknown but HER influence is very known.

#### **DON'T BE THIRSTY TO GET NOTICE, BE HUNGRY TO GAIN INFLUENCE.**

4. Humble approach grants access and influence with Jesus.

#### **Luke 18:14 NIV**

**"I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."**

#### **E. EXPRESSIVE PETITION**

An incorrect patriarchal lens and even patriarchal exegetical commentary will have you believe that this question asked by Salome was somehow an affront to God to even think to approach, better yet ask Jesus such a question.

5. Salome courageously asked the question everyone had, but no one wanted to ask

6. Salome makes a petition on behalf of others and not herself

7. Salome disrupts the power structure

-She knew Jesus in a way that the others did not.

-She asked the question no other disciple was willing to ask

“WHAT EXPRESSIVE PETITIONS MUST YOU PRAY...What EXPRESSIVE PETITION must you say?”

8. Salome’s resilient spirit completely disrupts the status quo of cultural norms.

**STOP WAITING FOR THE CULTURE’S COSIGN, START WORKING THE MASTER’S DESIGN**

9. You Gotta risk put yourself out there

-Looking foolish in an attempt know Jesus more intimately.

10. Salome’s resiliency spirit revealed the secret of the kingdom of God.
