SCRIPTURE: ROMANS 10:12-13 NLT

SZN 1: REVIVAL THROUGH RHYTHM

ROMANS 10:12-13 NLT

“Jew and Gentile are the same in this respect. They have the same Lord, who gives generously to all who call on him. For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

INTRO:

This may arguably be the most important scripture in the entire bible.

1. THE RHYTHM OF THE SAVED IS TO CARE

Romans 10:1 NLT

“Dear brothers and sisters, the longing of my heart and my prayer to God is for the people of Israel to be saved.”

SAVED- to deliver, to heal, to preserve, to do well, to be made whole.

-Everyone can be saved!

YOUR CARE SHOWS UP IN YOUR PRAYER

-How your heart breaks should lead to spending time petitioning God for others!

YOUR CARE SHOWS UP IN WHAT YOU SHARE

-Do you share your story, Do you share your time, your resources, your wealth, your food, your stuff

-Do you care enough

-If you're saved, you should care!

-If you don't care, you may not be saved!

2. THE RHYTHM OF THE SAVED IS TO CONFESS

Romans 10:9 ESV

“because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

CONFESSION IS SAYING THE SAME THING AS GOD

Confess- homologeo- "to say the same thing" or "to agree".

-to agree with God

-acknowledging something to be true

-whether it's agreeing with God about your sin

-Confessing your faith. Confess your weakness, confessing m

CONFESSION IS AGREEING WITH GOD, THAT MY HEART BELIEVES JESUS IS GOD

Romans 10:10 ESV

“For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.”

-My words about myself and others and align with the words of Jesus.

-When they don't, I adjust my beliefs and my words!

-My belief aligns with Jesus

HIS WORD, BECOMES MY WORDS

-We sayin the same thing!

3. THE RHYTHM OF THE SAVED IS TO CALL

Romans 10:14 NLT

“But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?”

CALL OUT FOR OTHERS TO BELIEVE

-If you don't tell them, how will they believe!

Psalms 116:1-4 ESV

“I love the Lord, because he has heard my voice and my pleas for mercy. Because he inclined his ear to me, therefore I will call on him as long as I live. The snares of death encompassed me; the pangs of Sheol laid hold on me; I suffered distress and anguish. Then I called on the name of the Lord: “O Lord, I pray, deliver my soul!””

CALL OUT FOR OTHERS TO HEAR

Romans 10:15-17 ESV

“And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!” But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, “Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?” So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.”

-If you don't tell them how will they hear!
